Message from the Office

Well we have rolled into "fall" on Saturday Sept 23 at 12:50 am and the cooler mornings and day-time highs are a sign that we need to try on our fall layering gear. OP Branded clothing is coming soon if you are interested for your child/children. Stay tuned on that! If not, now is a good time to check closets and last year's clothes to see if it all still fits.

The staff at OP has been collaborating together to ensure the transition back to school was filled with fun and engaging activities. We reinforce our District Values every day (Respectful, Curious, Responsible, Collaborative, Resilient and Healthy) and are helping our young students with appropriate and safe play habits on the school playground particularly when 380 of them are outside at the same time for recesses. This can be a challenging time for children when there is so much action. but the work we do in the classroom and outside for recess reinforces basic social skills, problem-solviing techniques, conflict resolution strategies, and regulation strategies. These are all part of helping children understand how to navigate the different parts of a school day. We teach the children in class each day about respect and healthy relationships with others and supplement this with our Large Group Health lessons (usually held twice a month in the gym). We know parents are teaching these same values in the home so the consistent messaging to the children is so valuable for learning.

September had a number of activities including the Terry Fox Run, the Dawe Run (Grades 4 & 5), the start of Swim at School Sessions through the City of Red Deer (Grades 2 - 5), our first Healthy Hunger Hot Lunch (organized through School Council) and many activities that honored National Day for Truth and Reconciliation including Orange Shirt Day on September 28. We have a number of special event days coming up each month and will work with our Grade 5 Leadership Students to plan lots of fun activities with our OP Students throughout the year.

We look forward to meeting with our Parents in October for <u>Parent</u> <u>Teacher Interviews</u> - more information in the newsletter & on the OP Website. If you work or are gone on a holiday during those times, please simply connect with your child's teacher(s) to arrange an alternate time - we will be glad to accommodate. Feel free to call Jacki or Sandy if you need any help booking an interview.


Scholastic Book Fair

This year, our Grades 2 - 5 are doing the lessons, but next year, we will revert back to the regular Grade 2 - 4 student lessons (Grade 5's included the last 2 years due to missing this during Covid-19).

Parents will get a PowerSchool Messenger TEXT the morning of your child's lesson to remind you to pack their swim gear, a towel, a plastic bag for wet gear, goggles (if they have them) and an extra snack - they are so hungry after their lesson!

In order for parents to volunteer in the classroom or on a field trip, you must have an RCMP Criminal Record Check. There is a \$10 fee required by the City of Red Deer for this CRCheck. You can apply for the Crim Record Check ONLINE through the <u>City of Red Deer using this link</u>. You will require a letter from OP School to upload in your application for the Crim Record Check. Sandy will email you a digital copy of this letter for you to upload in your application upon your request. Please return your Criminal Record Check to the principal when everything is done. Thank you so much for helping out and volunteering with our students!

Outdoor Video Surveillance Cameras

Due to the amount of vandalism, window breaking, grafitti and other negative activity in the evenings and weekends at OP School & playground area, video surveillance cameras were installed on the outside of our building. The installation finished on September 18 and the cameras have been functional since then. We have ordered the signage to inform the public as per <u>Admin Procedure 181</u>.

With the installation of the cameras, we have the ability to provide video footage to the RCMP) it necessary in the event of an incident or criminal offense.

Bright Space - for Parents and Guardians

Bright Space for Parents - as your child goes through Red Deer Public Schools, you will be directed to a Learner Management Platform called Bright Space. Although we use it at a basic level in Elementary School, you will be directed more and more to this platform as your child goes through Middle and High School. This is where their assignments will be housed and it will connect with PowerSchool to track their marks/grades in each of their courses.

Brightspace for Parents and Guardians gives parents access to the student Activity Feed, Work to Do (upcoming due dates), Grades, and Portfolio. Parents may also choose to receive a weekly summary by enabling this in their notifications. Parents do not have access to teacher Content pages, or assessments unless they log in as their child. At the Elementary level, most of this is not applicable but as your child goes through school, you can track their progress through Bright Space.

If you've been on the BrighSpace platform in the past, there was an upgrade over the summer that will require you to re-set your password (you can actually reset it to the same password - but it does require a re-set).

Parents who have never logged in before may continue to follow the instructions on the **Brightspace for Parent and Guardian Guide**.




