Message from the Office

What a change from last December! OP Students are enjoying wonderful time outside in this mild start to our winter! But we know a true Alberta winter is just around any corner, so make sure your child has warm layers to wear, warm winter boots, and gloves/toques/scarves/neck warmers, etc. Our threshold is minus 20-22 before we consider staying inside and we go out AT LEAST three times per day (3 recesses and possibly for PE class too). Children need fresh air and exercise to recharge their brain and bodies so they are ready to learn and we have so much fun outside playing with our friends! We do have a stash of toques & gloves on hand in the office if someone forgets theirs and needs to borrow for a recess or PE.

Our OP Food Hamper Drive is still underway, but will wrap up on December 7th. Although we will accept toonies &/or non-perishable food donations at our Winter Concert on Dec 13 & 14, our hope is that the bulk of our food is ready for our EA's to sort into hampers on Dec 7 & 8 when there are no classes in session. If you are able to donate please send your non-perishable food item by Dec 7th. If you are not able to donate and would benefit from support at Christmas, please contact our CLW Carla Feldberg to be added to our hamper list. Together we can make a difference for those in need.

January (weather permitting - and assuming the City of Red Deer can prepare the ice surface in this unseasonably warm weather) will see our skating unit begin. Try on their skates at home if you have some and if those skates no longer fit your children, please consider donating them to our Phys Ed program. Many families cannot afford skates so for those children who do not have their own, they need to borrow skates from the school to participate in class. Students typically go out once/week for 1 hour to skate and you are most welcome to come and help at a time where you can watch your child skate (no hockey sticks allowed during skating time).

If you need help setting up your Parent PowerSchool Portal, here are the instructions - or here is a link to video instructions. You can always call Jacki in the office for assistance as well. When you log into **PowerSchool**, find and click on the "Navigation" arrow (top left) and clid on RDP Reports. You will find the current term Report Card for your child under that menu. Click on Report Card & review it at your convenience. Then, make an appointment during Parent Teacher Interviews to discuss your child's progress with their teacher(s).

OP Reading Challenge

Our Reading Challenge is underway and we are so excited to see so many students participate again! The prizes may be a small token, but the kids love receiving them and the rewards of adding nightly reading compounds the benefits. Students in all grades are challenged to read at home (15 minutes/night for K-2 students and 30 minutes/night for Grades 3-5). Tracking the minutes and handing in a "ticket" will earn a weekly prize. The real reward comes from sharing time together as a family and modeling the importance and value of literacy. It is literacy skills that directly equate to student success in school - so any reading that students do over and above what we do at school is a benefit to your child.

Our school utilizes the SchoolMessenger system to deliver text messages straight to your mobile phone with important information on student attendance, school events and other activities.

You can participate in this service just by sending a text message of "Y" or "YES" to our District's short code number # 978338.

You can also opt out of these messages at any time by simply replying to one our messages with "STOP".

- 2. Click on SchoolEngage left hand side near the bottom
- 3. Click on "Students" -left hand side towards the top. Choose the student. If there is a red number beside a student name, it means they have an assigned form awaiting completion.
- 4. On the right, click the green "New" button of the form you are wanting to complete.
- 5. Read through the form and complete.
- 6. Click the green "Submit" button at the bottom of the form.


